



The Anglican Chaplaincy in Norway

The Church at your service

The Anglican Church is working here in Norway providing services in English and support to English speaking people from all over the world and from many different denominations. We would be pleased to welcome you to our services and the friendly communities we have built up in various parts of this beautiful country. Please see our websites for further details.

Here in Norway all registered religious bodies (Christian, Jewish, Muslim etc) receive some financial support from the State and from the local municipality (kommune) where members, whatever their nationality, are resident. The amount allocated each year is based on the number of people who are "signed up" members on January 1st of that year. All registered religious bodies are required to keep a membership list and to check its accuracy annually. The State decides each year the contribution per member, and the kommune in which you live gives a similar though variable amount.

If you are resident in Norway and would like to support the work of the Anglican Church here, we would ask you to fill in the form below. Whilst costing you nothing, your support in this way is very important to us financially. When all those who value our English-language Anglican services and ministry in Norway complete this form, it results in a very useful sum without which we would not be able to afford the four chaplains we have, one based in Oslo, one in Stavanger, one in Bergen, and one in Trondheim. We also minister in other parts of the country providing, for example, English-language carol services at Christmas in centres as far apart as Tromsø and Kristiansand.

Children too can be included on the membership list, but no one can be on the member list of more than one religious community in Norway. If you are currently registered with another religious group, you must de-register with them when you apply to be on the membership list of the Anglican Chaplaincy. In the space below please give your full name and address and, where applicable, details of your family members who are resident in Norway with you and who are registered with the "Folkeregisteret". We are required by law to have the 11 digits Personal ID Number (personnummer) of all members, so please make sure you have filled this in correctly. It is helpful too if you could inform us of any change of address or other details so we can keep our records up to date. Both parents have to sign the form, when children below 15 years of age sign in. Children from 15 years of age and above, sign in their own form. These forms are not to be signed by the parents.
